

LATE MODELS TO BE ADDED WEEKLY AT CANAAN FAIR ASPHALT SPEEDWAY

In an unprecedented move, Canaan Fair Asphalt Speedway announced today that they are adding Late Model Sportsmen to their card on a weekly basis for the 2010 racing season.

CFS General Manager, Dick Therrien stated “My phone has been ringing off the hook, and my inbox has been full of messages about bringing Late Models to Canaan on a regular basis since I took over this job in early November. There are a lot of Late Model race teams looking for a home, plus many cars sitting in storage that will be looking to make CFS there home in 2010. Also with so many new teams looking to race at Canaan in 2010, adding the Late Models was basically a no brainer. I sat down with the Henry’s and we devised a program which is going to be very unique for 2010. After that we will be tweaking the rules in 2011 and beyond to follow more of the ACT rules as most tracks in the area have adopted these rules thus allowing cars to race a more flexible schedule, and participate in the Tour’s traveling events. We at CFS are very excited about the addition of this division.”

For 2010 it is going to be a very unique set of rules as we will allow race teams to mandate what track rules they are using. If they should declare that they are running Twin State, WMMP, Riverside or ACT, they must be totally legal by their rules, and must stick to them for the season. We adjust the difference in rules by compensating with weight penalties. We will reserve the right to add or delete weight from each racecar in 2010 for the best interest of competition. We will also have a set of Canaan rules, which like Riverside, will offer special engine rules for non-crate motors. Canaan rules will also feature the same shock rules as ACT. The tire of choice for this class will be the Goodyear D2672 and the D2882. By going with this tire, it will allow teams to not have to make major chassis adjustments to compete at Canaan Fair Speedway.

To kick off this announcement, there will be a meeting for all interested parties at the Canaan Speedway Banquet Hall on Saturday, January 30th at 1:30pm. All teams interested in racing a Late Model at Canaan in 2010 are encouraged to attend this meeting. Topics to include rules, payoffs, schedule, etc.
