CANAAN DIRT SPEEDWAY TO ADD
YOUTH RACING FOR 2011

There are very few changes coming to the Canaan Dirt Speedway in 2011, under the new track lessee, Dick Therrien, but one exciting new change is the addition of youth racing at the ¼ mile track located in Canaan, New Hampshire.

“We have had numerous dirt teams inquiring about a youth racer division since we established the class on the “Awesome Asphalt” in 2010. Many dirt teams can’t afford to make a second trip to Canaan every week, and pay the extra pit fees so that their son or daughter can race on a Saturday night. I decided that since we are dropping the Mini Stock class in 2011, that now is the perfect time to introduce the Dirt Devils Youth Racing Division. This class will be open to all youngsters between the ages of 10-14. The rules will be the same as the dirt Bandit rules. This is designed so that families could use the same car in both divisions by simply making the seat adjustable. The Dirt Devils will run weekly in 2011. The Dirt Devils will race for just trophies, no money or points. This takes some of the pressure off of the kids to perform. I am very excited about this class for the kids. This allows youngsters the opportunity to learn about racing up close, and brings families together in the sport,” stated Therrien.
