

**11/18/2010 CANAAN FAIR ASPHALT SPEEDWAY
BECOMES ACT AFFILIATE TRACK FOR 2011**

Canaan Fair Speedway's "Awesome Asphalt" facility is pleased to announce that they have been added to the list of American Canadian Tour affiliate tracks for the 2011 racing season.

"This is a milestone step for our Speedway, declared new track lessee, Dick Therrien. This affiliation will put Canaan Fair Speedway on the map in the Northeast for Late Model racing. We added the class to our weekly lineup in 2010, and now we are affiliated with the premiere Northeast Late Model Tour, and this opens up so many doors for our program. The drivers who have heard about bits and pieces of this news are ecstatic and excited about the upcoming season. The phone is already ringing off the hook!"

What does this mean for Canaan Fair Speedway? All ACT legal race teams will be eligible to compete at New Hampshire Motor Speedway in the August, 2011 Indy Cup weekend, ACT event, providing that they meet the eligibility criteria which is being put together right now. This will allow the CFS Late Model teams the opportunity to fulfill their dreams of racing at Loudon. In past seasons the ACT Tour raced only once at New Hampshire, but this year the schedule has expanded to two events. The first event in August will be where race teams not only get a full weekend of racing, but they will be auditioning for the 43 car field that will make up the companion event in September's Sprint Cup race. This is great for all the race teams as they will not have to make a special trip to Loudon for a tryout day similar to what has taken place in the past. The August event will feature qualifying heats and last chance features on Friday, while the main event will take place on Saturday. The second giant part of the affiliation includes the opportunity for the 2011 Canaan Fair Speedway, Late Model champion to represent the track as a guaranteed starter in the September ACT event at Loudon.

"I couldn't be any more excited about anything we have put together yet for the 2011 season than this announcement. This is huge for my drivers and huge for my track! We are expecting numerous new teams to invade our track next season and this will be the icing on the cake for teams sitting on the fence. I want to thank Tom Curley and the entire ACT staff for giving us this major opportunity" stated Therrien.

One item not included in the 2011 package is that due to a full schedule of ACT events, Canaan Fair Speedway will not be hosting an American Canadian Tour event in 2011, however it will be hosting a \$5,000 to win event which will have Tom Curley's endorsement, and support. The date for this event will be announced in the very near future.
