

6/26/10 FELLOWS AND RENFREW GRAB WINS AT CANAAN FAIR SPEEDWAY

On a day when most tracks would have pulled the plug due to inclement weather, Canaan Fair Speedway held on til the bad weather passed and produced a great night of racing on the “Awesome asphalt.” Winners on the night included Aaron Fellows, Jimmy Renfrew, Scott MacMichael, Jamie Hodgdon, Kristen Ashley, Walter Hammond Jr., and Amanda Payea.

The New England Outdoor Furnaces Late Models took center stage Saturday night as the winner was guaranteed a starting spot at the \$5,000 to win Clash of the Titans II at Riverside Speedway in Groveton, New Hampshire on August 15th. The race lived up to its billing as the battles throughout the field were awesome. Aaron fellows took over the top spot on lap 38 and rolled on to the victory, but it was no easy trip for the current point leader. Jimmy Renfrew set a solid pace for the first 30 laps before the big guns raced from the back of the field to challenge the leader. Fellows got the jump on lap 38 but Renfrew continued to battle. Todd Davis slipped by Renfrew for second with nine laps to go with Renfrew and Donnie Lashua battling it out for third. The torrid battle saw Lashua edge out Renfrew for third. Fifth place went to Allen fellows. Renfrew and Aaron Fellows grabbed qualifying wins. Mark Merrill was the Late Model Lucky Dog Loot winner. He picked up a cool \$350, courtesy of Robbie Williams Excavating.

The Papa Z’s Pro Stocks continue to put on a great show as only two cautions dotted the 40 lap event. Jimmy Renfrew picked up the popular win over Donnie Lashua, newcomer, Jeremy Davis, Graylin Bonner and Corey Robert. Rob French and Renfrew picked up heat victories. This division is producing fantastic competition and is continuing to grow.

The Beard Sewer and Drain Super Streets had their best run of the season as just two cautions slowed the event. Scott MacMichael picked up the win outdistancing himself from the pack late in the race. Sid Laquire Jr. held off a hard charging Ed Laquire Jr. and Austin Brehio to grab the second spot. Rounding out the top five was Richard Dubeau.

Jamie Hodgdon dusted the field in the NAPA Pure Stocks. He raced home ahead of Randy McGee, Jessica Ovitt, Paul Sullivan and Andrew Merritt. McGee lost his spot in the tech area as he was too low, thus moving everyone up a spot with Thomas Coates Jr. moving into 5th place. Ovitt won her qualifier.

Kristen Ashley picked up her first ever main event win in the Bond Auto Parts Bandits as she held off point leader Michael Parker to secure the victory. Ryan Ovitt,

Amanda Denutte and Tyler Lescord rounded out the top five. Parker carried the heat checkers.

Walter Hammond Jr. drove an outstanding race in the S.K. Bean Enfield Garage Daredevils feature as he held off division hotshoe Brandon Gray for the big win. Mariah Gray raced home third.

The Champ Karts made their second appearance of the season and a wild one it was, as Tyler Lescord flipped his kart over the top of turn two bringing out the red flag. Lescord was alright but it ended his night. Amanda Payea, Dylan Payea, Rich Nye, Brian Henry and Lescord completed the top five. Amanda Payea also won her heat race.

The biggest event of the year happens Saturday night, July 3rd as Northeast Waste Services, 95.3FM, Q106 and Noise "R" Us Fireworks presents the 4th of July weekend spectacular. The P.A.S.S. Super Late Models will be in town for a 150 green flag lap events, plus the P.A.S.S. Mods, Super Streets, Pure Stocks, Bandits, and Daredevils, plus Monster Trucks and Fireworks. Post Time is 5pm.
