

7/24/10 FELLOWS, SULLIVAN, OVITT & HAMMOND SCORE BIG WINS ON CANAAN ASPHALT

Canaan Fair Speedway played host to the Modified Racing Series and the Ricky Miller Memorial 112 this past Saturday night and the big winner was David's House. The event was sponsored Gateway Motors, LaValley Building Supply and Chappy's Concessions. Winners on the night included Eric Goodale, Billy Dixon, Aaron Fellows, Paul Sullivan, Ryan Ovitt and Walter Hammond Jr.

Aaron Fellows won an exciting New England Outdoor Furnaces Late Model Sportsman main event as he edged out hometown favorite, Donnie Lashua at the stripe. Joe Tetreault, Allen Fellows and Todd Davis completed the top. The order changed following post race inspections as Lashua and Allen Fellows both failed tech due to being too low. The official top five were Aaron Fellows, Tetreault, Davis, Matt Anderson and Mark Merrill. Ricky Bly won the qualifying event. Todd Davis won the \$500 Late Model Lucky Dog Loot prize courtesy of Wes Smith and New England Outdoor Furnaces.

It was a wild and woolly finish in the NAPA Pure Stocks as lapped traffic played a huge part in the outcome of the event. Randy McGee took the white flag in the lead position with Jamie Hodgdon and Paul Sullivan on his bumper, and looked like a winner until the third turn when lapped traffic forced the top three to split the lapped cars, then scramble to the finish. When the dust settled, somehow Paul Sullivan slipped by and grabbed the checkers. Hodgdon edged out McGee on a pair of flat left side tires for second, while McGee held on for third edging out point leader, Jess Ovitt at the stripe. Erin Vien rounded out the top five. Hodgdon carried the checkers in the lone qualifier.

Ryan Ovitt picked up his career first win in the Bond Auto Parts Bandits main event. Ovitt withstood a race long challenge from point leader Michael Parker to secure the victory. Kristen Ashley made a late race charge to secure the third spot ahead of Amanda Denutte and Kodi Sabens. Parker won the qualifying heat.

The S.K. Bean's Enfield Garage Daredevils put on one whale of a show and when the excitement was over Walter Hammond Jr. took the hard fought victory over Brandon Gray. Mariah Gray, Jessica Darling and Hunter Garduno completed the top five.

Eric Goodale won the Modified Racing Series feature and Billy Dixon won the P.A.S.S. Mod main event.
