Jamie Hodgdon secured the lead early and never looked back as he scored another win in the NAPA Pure Stocks. Jessica Ovitt raced home second, followed by Paul Sullivan, Erin Vien and Andrew Merritt. Ovitt picked up the win in the preliminary round.

Michael Parker gathered up another victory in the Bond Auto Parts Bandits. Kristen Ashley raced by Tyler Lescord and Ryan Ovitt on the last lap to grab the second spot. Doug Boucher completed the top five. Parker also won the qualifying heat.
