

**8/14/10 RENFREW, LASHUA AND MILLER JR.  
WIN BIG ON CANAAN ASPHALT**

The racing action continues to be red hot at the “Awesome asphalt” at Canaan Fair Speedway as several new drivers rolled into the pits to take on the challenge of Canaan fair Speedway. Winners on the night included Jimmy Renfrew, Donnie Lashua, David Miller Jr., Randy McGee, Michael Parker, Bobby Prior, and Walter Hammond Jr.

Jimmy Renfrew held off repeated challenges by Chris Wilk over the final 20 laps of the Papa Z’s Pro Stock main event to claim another victory and strengthen his point lead over Walt Hammond. Cory Robert raced home third ahead of Donnie Lashua and Walt Hammond. Jeremy Davis and Robert won their respective qualifiers.

Donnie Lashua picked up his first win in the New England Outdoor Furnaces Late model feature as he held off a determined Aaron Fellows to secure the win. Matt Anderson raced home third, followed by Mark Merrill and Mike Davis. Lashua also won the qualifying heat. Davis captured the Late Model Lucky Dog Loot bonus which was sponsored by RPM Racing Engines out of Georgia, Vermont, and New England Outdoor Furnaces.

David Miller Jr. led all 25 laps of the Beard Sewer and Drain Super Street feature and collected his first career win in the class. Sid Laquire Jr., Ed Laquire Jr., Scott MacMichael and Sparky MacIver chased him to the stripe. Miller and MacMichael won the preliminary round.

Randy McGee held off a determined effort by points leader, Jessica Ovitt to claim his first ever NAPA Pure Stock main event. Thomas Coates Jr., Robbie Thompson and Andrew Merritt completed the top five.

Michael Parker picked up an easy win in the Bond Auto Parts bandits as he easily outdistanced Kristen Ashley, Ryan Ovitt, Matt Sonnhalter and newcomer, Shawn Swallow. Parker also won the lone qualifier.

Walter Hammond Jr. scored a popular win in a wild S.K. Bean, Enfield Garage daredevils main event. He survived four cautions to claim the victory over Andrew Martel, Mariah Gray, Jessica Darling and Joey Laquerre.

Bobby Prior won the Optical Expressions, Berlin Outlaw Mini main event. Trevor Perreault and Robert Gioia completed the top three.
