**It was a bonsai charge to the front for Papa Z's Pro Stock winner, Chris Wilk as he was involved in a crash early in the race, and then blasted his way to the front in the outside groove to collect the victory. Wilk got the edge on a late race restart to beat Jeremy Davis to the stripe. Donnie Lashua, Walt Hammond and Graylin Bonner rounded out the top five. Brian Henry and Wilk scored wins in the preliminary rounds.**

**Aaron Fellows took advantage of an ill handling Donnie Lashua racer, and took over the lead with four laps to go to pick up the win in the New England Outdoor Furnaces Late Model main.
