Early afternoon showers passed and Canaan Fair Speedway's "Awesome Asphalt" played host to another great evening of racing on Beard Sewer and Drain Night. Winners included Donnie Lashua, Aaron Fellows, Scott MacMichael, Jessica Ovitt, Ryan Ovitt and Brandon Gray.

Hometown hero, Donnie Lashua cruised to victory in the Papa Z's Pro Stocks main event as he easily outdistanced point leader Jimmy Renfrew for the win. Renfrew overcame an early race incident to place second ahead of Jeremy Davis, Bobby MacArthur and Cory Robert. Robert scored the win in the qualifying heat.

Aaron Fellows rolled to another victory over a solid field of cars in the New England Outdoor Furnaces Late Models. He was able to withstand a late race challenge from Donnie Lashua to secure the victory. Newcomers John Dickerman and Zig Geno raced home third and fourth ahead of Mark Merrill.
