

**8/6/11 LASHUA, LABINE, OVITT & FRASER
BEAT THE RAINS AT CANAAN'S "AWESOME ASPHALT"**

Mother Nature continues to plague racing at Canaan Fair Speedway's in Canaan, New Hampshire as the Pro Stocks and Bandits feature events were postponed due to rain showers this past Saturday night, setting up a huge event this coming Saturday night at 5pm. The Pro Stocks will race triple 30's, while the Bandits will run twin 20's, due to several rain shortened shows in recent weeks. Each event will carry a separate purse.

Several features were run before the rains came and winners included Donnie Lashua, Bob Labine, Ryan Ovitt and Zac Fraser.

The New England Outdoor Furnaces Late Models were out in force and Donnie Lashua came home victorious. Lashua cruised to victory while Tyler Alati and Chris Bergeron ran side by side for more than ten laps before Bergeron edged ahead to capture the second spot. Alati settled for third, followed by Bruce Jaycox and Bucky Demers. Lashua and Alati picked up qualifying wins.

The Beard Sewer & Drain Super Streets saw a battle for the win right to the checkers as Bob Labine fought off a hard charging Rich Dubeau to claim the win. Chris McKinstry raced home third, followed by Todd Bragg and Craig Smith. Labine also picked up the qualifying round victory.

Showers started to roll in during the NAPA Pure Stock main event. After a short delay, the balance of the feature was completed just before steadier rain ended the night. Ryan Ovitt picked up the win over Kyle Davis, Randy McGee, Paul Sullivan and Walter Hammond. Ovitt also claimed the heat win.

The S.K. Bean, Enfield Garage Daredevil top five were Zac Fraser, Scott Tracey, Kyle Wilson, Brie-Anna Menard and Lauryn Rexford.

It will be a huge Saturday night this coming weekend as The Pro Stocks will race Triple 30 lap main events. The fields are set for the June 25th makeup event, as well as August 6th makeup race. All Pro Stocks will be eligible to race in the third 30 lap main event. The Bandits will have Twin 20 lap features with the makeup August 6th events field all set, but any Bandit will be eligible for the second 20 lap event. Each Pro Stock and Bandit feature will carry a full purse and normal championship points. Joining the Pro Stocks and Bandits on Miller Auto and NAPA night will be the Super Streets, Pure Stocks, Daredevils and S.T.A.R. Antique Racers. There will be a special post time of 5pm. Pits will open at 1pm with practice beginning at 2pm for the S.T.A.R. racers. Race fans will enjoy this huge event for just \$10 for Adults, \$8 for Jr. & Sr., Kids 11 & under are free.
