

## **9/10/11 FELLOWS, DAVIS AND MCKINSTRY SCORE BIG WINS ON CANAAN'S "AWESOME ASPHALT"**

**This past Saturday night on the "Awesome Asphalt" at Canaan Fair Speedway in Canaan, New Hampshire saw some of the five divisions points battle tighten up, while one division pretty much wrapped up the season title. Winners on Beard Sewer and Drain night included Aaron Fellows, Jeremy Davis, Chris McKinstry, Walter Hammond, Matt Boucher and Jessica Darling.**

**Jeremy Davis survived a nine car pileup on lap #1 of the Papa Z's Pro Stocks, to go on and pick up his second victory of 2011. After "The big one", the field was sent to the pit area for repairs and came back out to finish the night at the end of the show. Ricky Bly held off point leader Donnie Lashua for the second spot. They were followed by Sulo Burbank and newcomer Scott MacMichael. Bly and Cory Robert secured heat wins. Heading into championship night, Donnie Lashua leads Jeremy Davis by 32, and both Cory Robert and Sulo Burbank are just 34 points back. 60 points will be available to each driver on Saturday night.**

**Aaron Fellows picked up a big win in the New England Outdoor Furnaces Late Model feature and took advantage of point leader, Donnie Lashua's ninth place finish to close within 10 points for the season finale championship night. Tyler Alati, Mark Merrill, Chris Bergeron and Bucky Demers completed the top five. Merrill and Bergeron won their respective qualifiers.**

**The Beard Sewer and Drain Super Streets saw Chris McKinstry race to a hard fought win over Craig Smith, Rich Dubeau, Trever Perreault and Todd Bragg. The Super Streets feature the tightest point battle of all as Rich Dubeau leads Craig Smith by a mere 4 points, and Todd Bragg is right in the hunt only 24 points back. Heat checkers were carried by Perreault and McKinstry.**

**Walter Hammond continues to be red hot in the NAPA Pure Stocks as he cruised the outside lane for another solid victory. Randy McGee, Thomas Coates Jr., Ryan Ovitt and Matt Lashua rounded out the top five. Hammond also won the heat race. All Ryan Ovitt has to do is take the green flag in the Napa Pure Stock feature event and the rookie driver will claim his first ever track championship. He holds a 50 point lead. However the battle for position two through four is separated by just 5 points. Randy McGee has a 2 point edge over Kyle Davis, and 5 points over Paul Sullivan.**

**Matt Boucher did all he could to get back into the points hunt this past Saturday night in the Bond Auto Parts Bandit division, as he claimed another victory. Matt Morrill,**

point leader Kristen Ashley, Lenny Garduno and Josh Dunn followed Boucher to the stripe. Boucher and Lenny Garduno won their respective qualifiers. Boucher, who lost the point lead last week after being involved in an early race skirmish with a lapped car, closed the gap back to just 9 points heading into championship night.

Jessica Darling won a highly competitive S.K. Bean Enfield Garage Daredevil Youth racer event. Lauryn Rexford had a season best second place finish, ahead of Kyle Wilson, Zac Fraser and Aaron Poulin.

This Saturday night will be the final event of 2011 on the “Awesome Asphalt”, as New England Outdoor Furnaces presents all the championship night festivities. A special 5pm post time will be observed this week. All six divisions will be in action including Pro Stocks, Late Models, Super Streets, Pure Stocks, Bandits, Daredevils, and Kids Bike Races.
