CANAAN FAIR SPEEDWAY CONTEST BOARD RULING

The Canaan Fair Speedway Contest Board met on Tuesday, June 21, 2011 to make a decision about a formal protest in the finish of the event. Chris Wilk filed the official protest following the event. His protest consisted of the winner, Donnie Lashua being a lap down.

Contest Board members:

Dick Therrien, Charlie Rockwell, Stuart Bean, Kristen Bragg, and Dan Henry.
Dan Henry recused himself as he had been involved with the Lashua team in the past.

Also present was Donnie Lashua. Protester, Chris Wilk was unable to attend due to work commitments.

Evidence: Track made mistake in telling Lashua that he was on the lead lap when he inquired early in the event.

Evidence: Chris Wilk wanted to enter a video showing Lashua was a lap down.

After reviewing all the evidence, the Contest Board came up with this decision. By reviewing score sheets this decision was resolved. There was no reviewing of the video whatsoever by the board, and there will not be any video reviewing in the future!

The decision is as follows:

Donnie Lashua will keep the win with the following agreed upon condition. He will be paid the winners purse, \$1,000, but will receive points for the last car on the lead lap. This will place him in 6th position for points only.

Kris Lyman will receive first place points, and also receive a check for \$1,000, the winners share, not \$800 for second place.

Ricky Bly will receive second place points, and a check for \$800, not \$500 for third place.

Chris Wilk will receive third place points, and \$500, not \$400 for fourth place.

Rich Eaton will receive 4th place points, and \$400 not \$300 for fifth place.

Erick Sands will receive 5th place points, and \$300, not \$275 for sixth place.

Track management added \$725 to the purse to make this fair adjustment for all parties involved. The decision was based upon fairness to Lashua due to misinformation provided by the track, and to consider the “What If” factor in rendering its decision.

“I am very satisfied with the outcome of this decision, but also feel there are some things that we need to do better in the future. We have come up with a plan to eliminate the problems that we encountered on Saturday night. Steps will be taken tomorrow morning on making these improvements.” stated General Manager, Dick Therrien.
