

2009 Handicap Procedures for Canaan Fair Speedway

Canaan Speedway management has adopted a new handicapping procedure for the 2009 racing season. The old system had some flaws in it and we think we have closed the gap in making it fair to all competitors. With this new system a team can overcome a missed event either by choice or misfortune and still fight for a championship.

All cars will draw for heat race starting positions when they sign in for the evening's events. The top three finishers from the qualifiers will redraw for feature starting positions prior to their feature event. With the exception of last weeks feature winner, they will start in the last position.

Example: All 4th place finishers will start 10th, 11th, or 12th. All 6th place finishers will start 16th, 17th, or 18th.

You will be considered Qualified if you are one of the last 6 cars to leave the speedway, you do not have to take the checkered flag you just need to be scored as one of the last six to be competing.

If your car is broken during qualifying and there are less than 24 cars you will be able to start the event at the rear of the field. If your car is broken during qualifying and there are more than 24 cars you can be granted a provisional if it is not your first week of competition and there in not a non-qualifiers race. You must check with the handicappers before your race if you are to be granted a provisional starting position.

If there are more than 24 cars in your division the following procedure will happen:

- A. Top 6 from each qualifier will receive qualifying points with the top 3 for each qualifier redrawing for feature positions. This will happen with the winners from the qualifiers drawing 1st. runner-ups next and 3rd place finishers drawing last unless last weeks feature winner is in this group then they will not draw.
- B. If there is no consolation race then the cars will be lined up as they finished in the qualifiers, with 1st heat being first, 2nd heat being second, and 3rd heat being third to line up.
- C. If there is a non-qualifiers race then the amount of cars to start will be determined that night before the non-qualifiers race so that all will know before they race. We may choose to start more than 24 cars.

If there are 1-7 cars there will be one heat. If there are 8-18 cars there will be two heats. If there are 19 or more cars there will be three heats.

The Bandits, Outlaw Mini's and Pure stocks will run 20 laps, the Super Streets and Modifieds will run 30 laps, and the Pro Stocks will run 40 laps.

Any teams coming to compete that have not participated in at least 2 events prior to 8/15/09, after the events on 8/15/09 will not draw for Qualifying positions they will be placed at the rear of the fields as deemed necessary by track management so as not to disrupt points battles that are taking place in the divisions.

In the event of inclement weather conditions points will be awarded for completed events. Completed events will be broken up into Qualifying and Feature events. A feature event will be considered complete when half of the allotted laps are completed. Incomplete events will be issued NO points or monies.

Qualifying will be considered complete when all divisions have qualified and the 1st feature event has completed half of the allotted laps.

Starting 8/15/09 all new cars will start at the rear of the feature event.

All decisions will be made in the best interest of safety by CFS officials and are subject to change as deemed necessary.
